Dr. Marc Holzer (M.P.A., Ph.D. University of Michigan) is dean and Board of Governors Professor in the School of Public Affairs & Administration at Rutgers-Newark and is one of the most distinguished researchers in the field of public administration. Among other honors, Dr. Holzer is a National Academy of Public Administration (NAPA) Fellow and past President of the American Society for Public Administration (ASPA). Dr. Holzer's research on topics such as performance measurement, public productivity, state and local government, citizen participation, e-government, and the treatment of government and bureaucracy in movies and literature has resulted in over 100 books, articles, and book chapters. Since 1975 Dr. Holzer has directed the National Center for Public Performance, and he is the founder and editor-in-chief of the journals *Public Performance and Management Review* and *Public Voices* and is the co-founder/co-editor of the *Chinese Public Administration Review*.
